The Hawai'i Gender ECHO Program (G-ECHO) was created to expand access to gender-affirming care for keiki in Hawai'i. In collaboration with medical and behavioral health clinicians, providers and members of the community, and The Hawai'i Department of Health, Gender and Sexual Minority Workgroup, we have curated a network of affirming providers and identified referral pathways to make care more accessible. This directory is intended for gender expansive youth and families in Hawai'i. Services included fall into one of the following categories: behavioral health, community groups, housing and basic needs, medical, community resource, and social services.
