Legislative Committee Report Co-chairs: Clair Townsend Ing & Leocadia Conlon

- Priority area for 2021 legislative session was Diversity, Equity and Inclusivity
- Submitted 19 testimonies on 17 bills and signed onto 3 public health advocacy efforts. Examples of testimony:
 - o HCR 112, HR 90 Declaring Racism as a Public Health Crisis
 - SB2342, Support Relating to the Kupuna Caregivers Program
 - o HB2043, Relating to Adolescent Mental Health Care
 - o HB 2254, Relating to Loan Repayment for Health Care Professionals
 - SB2392, Relating to Health, supporting funds for 'Imi Ho'olas student stipends
 - SB512, Supporting Fresh Food Options for SNAP recipients
 - o SB502, Guarantee all Individuals the Right to have a Clean and Healthy Environment
 - SB1258 &SB970, Relating to Telehealth
 - HB 1296, Opposition to Repeal of the Tobacco Prevention and Control Trust Fund
 - HCR 59, HR 48, Supporting Efforts to Implement Statewide Strategy to Eliminate Hepatitis A, B and C in Hawaii



- APHA had a successful hybrid annual meeting in Denver, Colorado on October 23-27 with both virtual and in-person sessions. The meeting theme Creating the Healthiest Nation: Strengthening Social Connectedness drew many sessions supporting ways to address the social disruptions exacerbated by COVID-19, misinformation and racial injustice. Recordings of all sessions are available to those registered through early 2022.
- The incoming APHA President is Kaye Bender, who will present at today's meeting, and the new President-Elect is Chris Chanyasulkit.
- APHA will hold its 150 Anniversary meeting in Boston, MA next year, November 6-9. 150 Years of Creating the Healthiest Nation: Leading the Path Toward Equity. Abstracts will be due early in 2022.
- National Public Health Week 2022 is April 4-10. The theme is Public Health is Where You Are.
