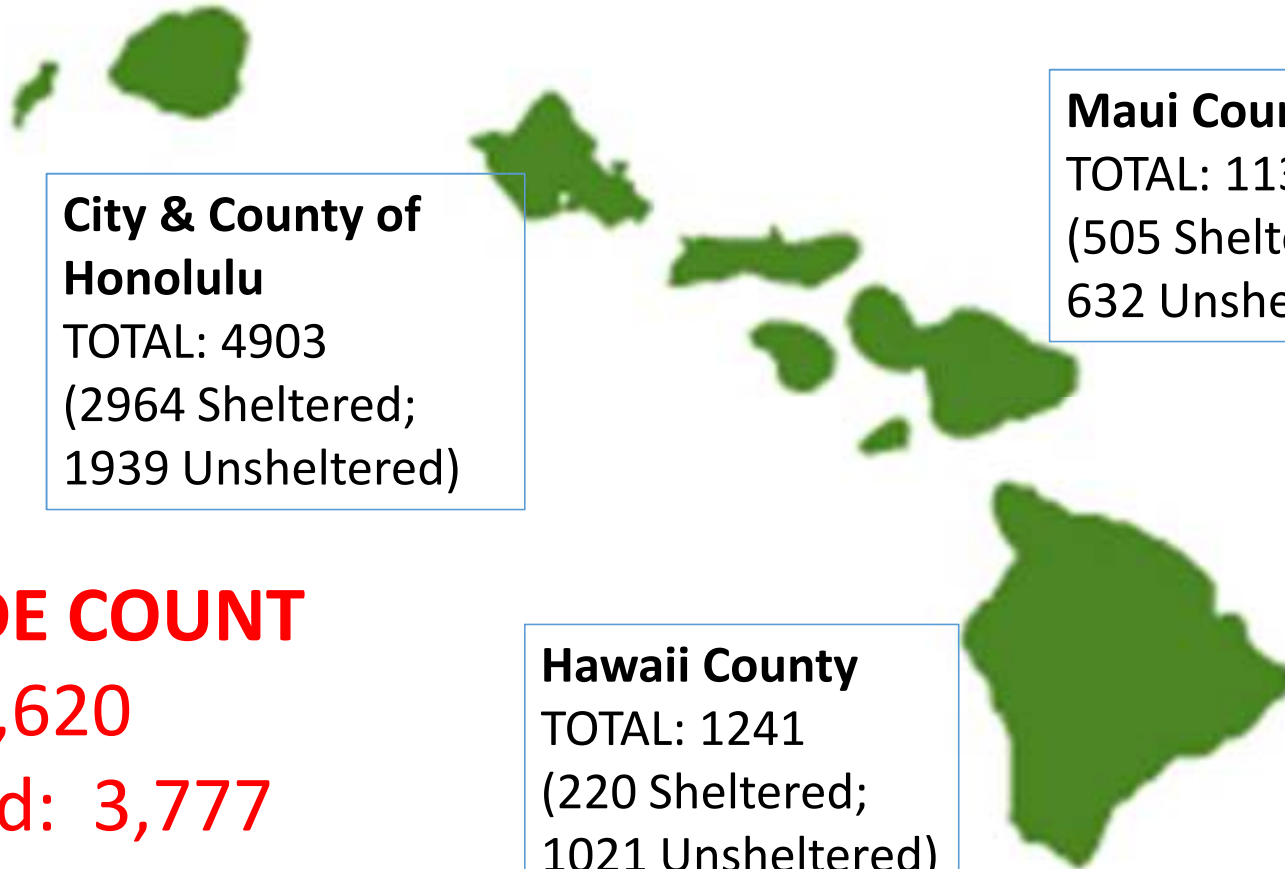

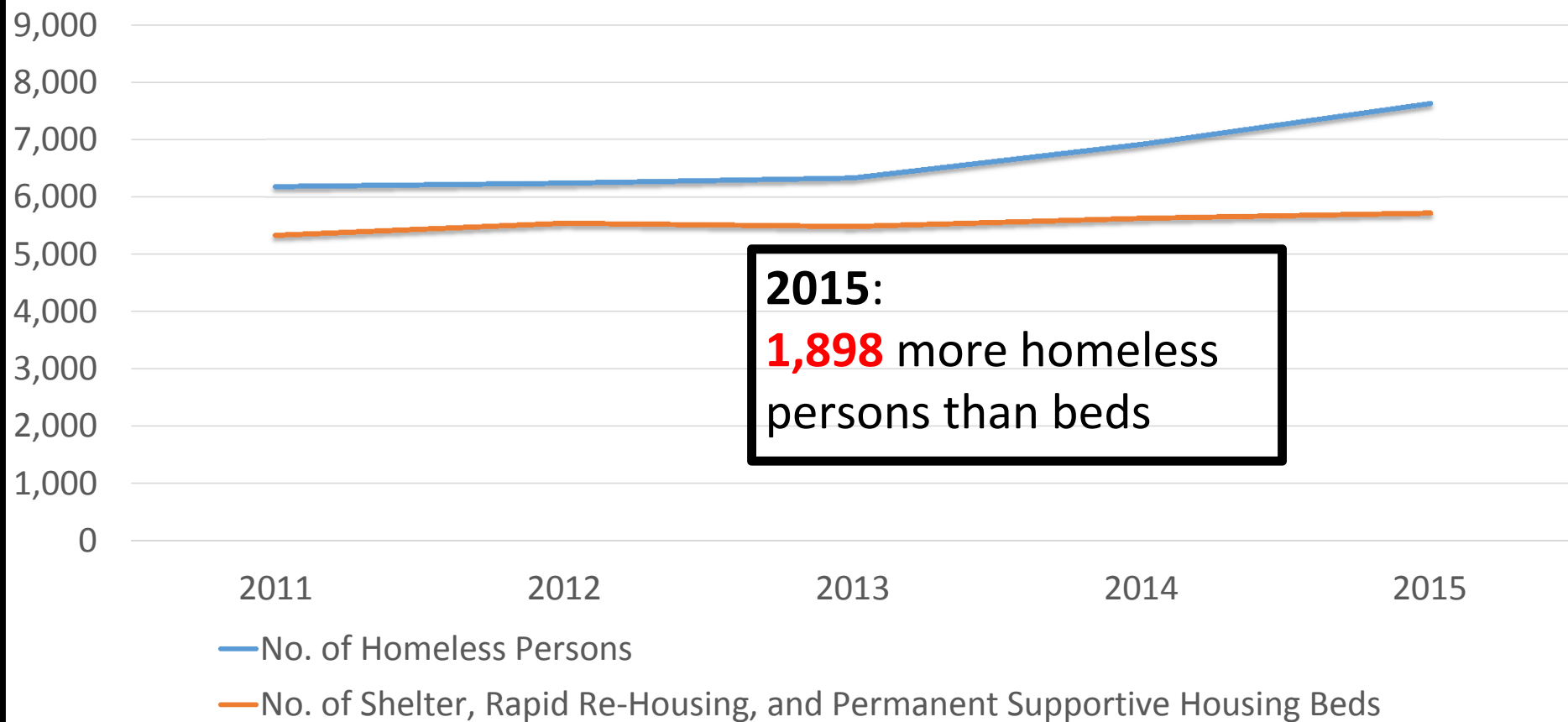

LEVER 3:

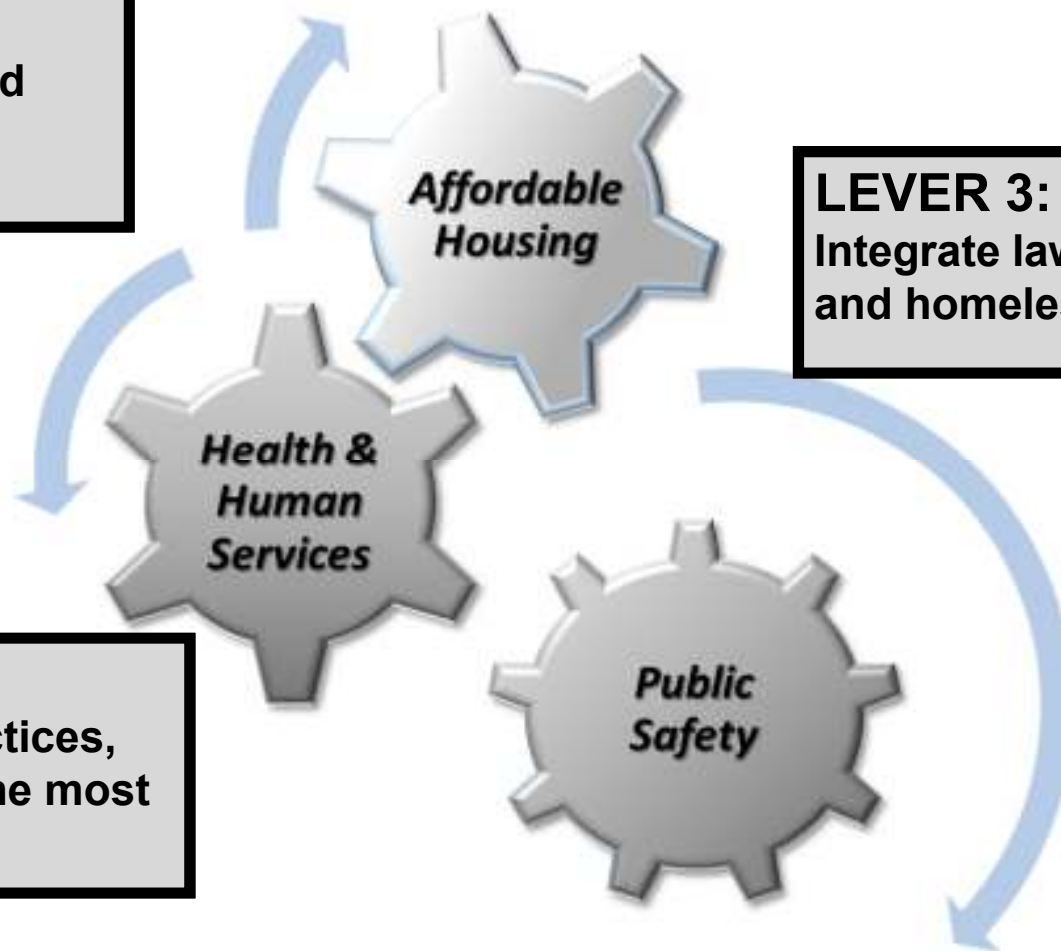
Integrate law enforcement and homeless services.
