About National Public Health Week

Each year in April, public health is celebrated across the United States in a collaborative effort lead by the American Public Health Association. This year's National Public Health Week theme "**Centering & Celebrating Cultures in Health**" plans to engage communities and sectors in a conversation focusing on how our cultures have always shaped our health. We learn from the communities we are born in and build together. We look to community leaders as our health leaders. We will celebrate the unique and joyful ways different cultures focus on health and explore how we can learn from each other with humility and openness.

Hawaii's Celebration

In Hawaii, we will celebrate National Public Health Week on Thursday, April 6th with a unique and interactive virtual program focusing on "**Celebrating Cultures in Health**" featuring community speakers and engagement by event participants. HPHA's NPHW events draw over 150 attendees each year comprised of public health professionals, community health workers, Department of Health employees and students. HPHA has over 30 partners who share and forward communications to their listserv, and we estimate over 10,000 impressions of your logo with our event marketing.

- Typically 1,800 monthly website views from approximately 650 users
